## PRENATAL CLINICS of the CIUSSS de la Capitale-Nationale

The prenatal clinic is a special place for you to discuss your concerns and needs regarding your pregnancy, birth, breastfeeding and return home with a nurse. She will meet you between the 10<sup>th</sup> and the 13<sup>th</sup> week of your pregnancy to:

- Take your blood samples;
- Give you the guide « From Tiny Tot to Toddler »;
- Provide you with the appropriate resources for your needs;
- Discuss any topic that is important to you;
- Ensure continuity of services with the desired place of birth.

Pregnant women living with no or low income may be eligible for the Olo Program (Eggs, milk, vegetables) or the SIPPE (Integrated Perinatal and Early Childhood Services) Program as early as the 12<sup>th</sup> week of pregnancy. If you think you may be eligible, talk to the prenatal clinic nurse.

### FOR THE ROUTINE 2 APPOINTMENT:

For Rh positive women, the staff will schedule your appointment in a lab test clinic. For Rh negative women, the staff will schedule your appointment at a prenatal clinic.
