

GENERALS INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE EYE SURGERY

These instructions apply to all eye surgery

Before the surgery:

- The day before your surgery _____, a secretary will call you to inform you the time you have to present yourself to the hospital. You will not be call on week-ends or during holidays.
- If we cannot reach you, you have to call us between 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm at 418 682-7511 extension 4542.
- If you are sick, have fever, are hospitalised or you have to cancel your surgery, please call us as soon as possible at 418 682-7511 extension 4542. Leave your name and phone number on the voicemail, we will call you back.

The day of your surgery:

- Come to the admission office of the eye surgery, on the 6th floor of the hospital.
- Bring your Saint-Sacrement hospital card (if you have one) and your medical card.
- You must be accompanied by a responsible adult at the time of discharge. You cannot drive. You cannot use city transport.
- You will need some someone to assist you during the first 24 hours following surgery. You will need someone to accompany you to your medical follow-up appointment.
